SACRED MUSIC FESTIVAL - INSTRUCTION

(Jointly organised by Samajam and DSMC)

The Sacred Music Festival is organized under the joint auspices of the Sunday School Samajam and the DSMC, based on the endowment instituted in memory of Respected Rev. C.V. Abraham Kashisha, by his son Mr. George C. Abraham (USA) and by His Grace, RT. Rev. Dr. Joseph Mar Barnabas Suffragan Metropolitan, on the occasion of his Episcopal Silver Jubilee.

Conditions

The music festival is held in two sections.

1. Juniors (Children of Junior and Intermediate Classes)

2. Seniors (Children of Senior and Young Adult Classes)

3. Songs for Divya Sangeetholsavam are included in Samajam Website: samajam.marthoma.in

4. Each group should have at least 5 members. Maximum 7 members can participate in a group. It can be sung by boys alone and girls alone or combined as a group.

5. No musical instruments can be used while singing. But, if necessary, pitch pipe or any other musical instrument can be used to obtain the pitch.

6. Each Sunday School may send one team each in the two divisions to the Centre level.

7. A letter certified by the respective Vicar stating the Name and Date of Birth of the participating team members must be provided at the time of registration for each level of participation. Only team members who have successfully participated at the Centre level will be eligible to participate in the Diocesan and Kendhra level.

8. Divine Music Festival at the Centre-Diocesan levels shall be conducted along with Talent Test at their respective levels.

In each category, two songs decided by the judges should be sung.
